Course Overview

Consider the facts; At least 50 percent of the time you are in a low-light environment. About 60 percent of deadly force encounters in the U.S. occurs in low-light environments. Are you ready for a short-time duration, close proximity, low-light encounter? After attending this course you will be.

The objective of this course is to develop the skills and confidence required to prevail with the pistol in low light conditions. Upon completion, shooters will understand how to effectively and safely engage targets in a diminished light environment using the most up-to-date techniques available today.
